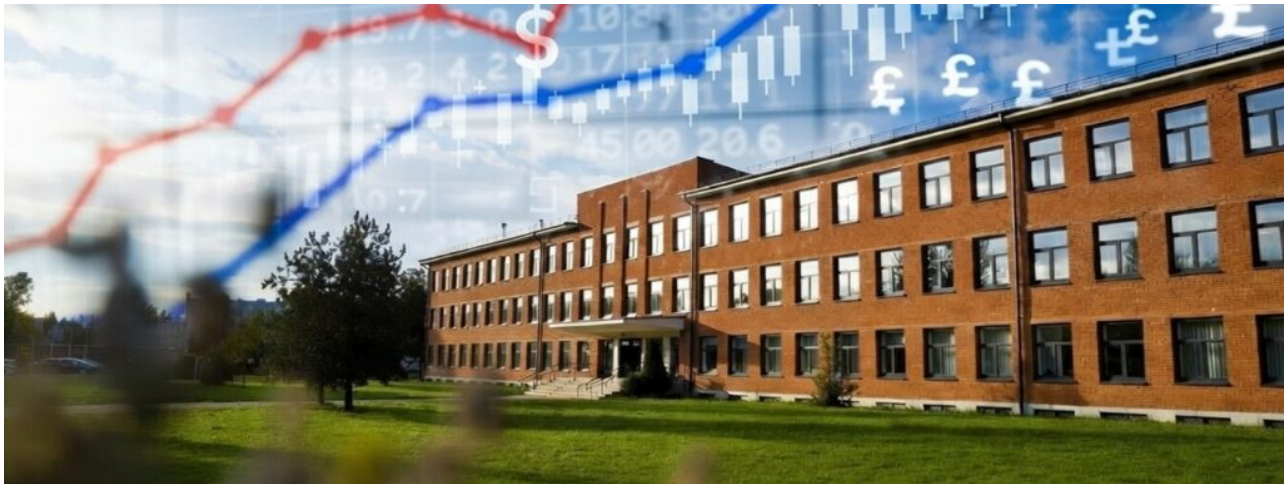


# Securing Funding and Optimizing Spend for UK School Estates in 2026 - A Forward-Thinking Path to Excellence

**Recapping:** We’ve covered announcements and needs; now, as our network schools, seize 2026’s funding to excel. Picture optimized spends creating thriving environments— with £67 billion in core budgets and multi-year commitments, you’re positioned for success. This finale guides securing resources, emphasizing positive actions while noting this key juncture for FM providers to engage as solution partners.

DfE streams like SCA, CIF, and DFC persist, with 2026-27 uplifts incorporating SBSG and others. Core budgets hit £67 billion, including £2.3 billion annual repairs and £2.4 billion for 500 rebuilds, expanding to 750 via SRP’s £20 billion. High needs operational guidance for 2026-27, published January 2026, details place funding notifications by March, with no transfers over 0.5% without approval and growth at £1,570/£2,350 per pupil. Address the £6 billion SEND gap with £3 billion for adaptations.

Optimize via GEMS procurement, like modular for value. AI yields 10-15% efficiencies by 2027, supporting 4% teacher pay rises via £615 million. Green ties to Climate Plans save; tap WCIT grants for tech.

Leaders advocate evidence-based bids with CDC2. This dynamic landscape invites FM companies to step forward, offering expertise in net-zero and adaptive solutions— a prime opportunity to partner in this conversation.

The January 2026 PE funding resolution bolsters holistic spends, like sports facilities.

- Allocate budgets preventively, integrating AI for efficiencies.
